### Referendum Regarding the Continued Levy of Sales Surtax by School Board to Finance Education Facilities

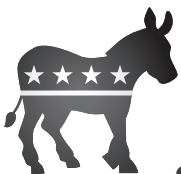
Shall a one-half cent sales surtax continue to be levied in Calhoun County for a period of ten (10) years, effective January 01, 2019, and expiring on December 31, 2028, with collections commencing January 01, 2019, to finance educational facilities, including construction, reconstruction, renovation, remodeling, land acquisition and improvement, retrofitting, enhancing safety, and the purchase of technology equipment, hardware and software for the Calhoun County School District?

- Yes = For the 1/2% (0.5 cents) tax
- No = Against the 1/2% (0.5 cents) tax
