

## Manual Audit of Voting Equipment Results General Election 2010

The publicly noticed audit of the Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 8 race in Precinct 11B occurred on November 16, 2010, at 2 p.m. in the Calhoun County Supervisor of Elections Office.
